SR 9.2 Classes:

KZN do not have class P therefore the class P entries received race in class A and are scored accordingly.

RallySafe:

With reference to the communiqué on 29 June, **please take note** that all installations will be checked by the Data Logging team. Failure to have the device mounted in accordance with the instructions will prevent the competitor from starting the event. Refer SSR 300 [x]

RallySafe Installation Guidelines

1. The Antenna Pack is to be installed on the TOP of the vehicle.
 - a. It must have a clear, unobstructed view of the sky. Failure to do so results in poor signal reception and loss of functionality.
 - b. Any locations other than on TOP of the vehicle are unacceptable.
2. The three antenna cables, must
 - a. be routed away from sharp edges
 - b. not have any corners less than 100mm radius
 - c. be well protected from damage (add shielding if required)
 - d. excess cable (if any), must be made into a 200mm diameter loop
 - e. have sufficient free play at the connections to the RallySafe device
3. The RallySafe device must be installed in a position and location that it is in clear view and reach of the navigator
4. Connection of the three (3) antennae cables to the device must be snug to ensure they do not rattle loose during an event.
5. POWER lead – MUST be permanently powered. Fuses/breakers may be installed positive and negative leads, but the device MUST be powered up at all times during an event.
